



FIREARM SAFETY IN YOUR VEHICLE

Best practices...



Firearms stored in locked vehicles are at risk of theft.

Store your firearm out of plain sight using a safe or a lockbox.



Firearms in vehicles are a risk with young children.

Secure and/or unload your firearm when children are present.



Firearms in vehicles are a risk at large gatherings.

Secure your firearm(s) at home prior to attending.

Prevent firearm theft and misuse

1 When not in use, unload the firearm before entering the vehicle.

2 Always be aware of muzzle, direction, and other safe use rules.

3 Use a storage safe or lock box when possible.

4 When not in use, store ammunition separately and out of plain sight.

5 Securely attach the lock box or safe to the vehicle to prevent injury.

6 Double-check that your firearm is unloaded before storing it in a vehicle.

When your firearm is not under your control, **LOCK IT UP!**
